<b>Labelling</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All labeling of packaging of imports shall include English and/or Swahili;</li><li>• All imports with a limited shelf life shall have more than seventy five per cent (75%) shelf life from the date of expected landing in Kenya</li><li>• Packaged goods (e.g. foodstuffs, pharmaceuticals, chemicals, cosmetics, and similar) shall indicate the batch numbers and dates of expiration and/or date of production.</li></ul>
<b>The Certificate of Conformity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A <b>Certificate of Conformity</b> (CoC) should be issued to evidence the compliance of the shipments.</li><li>• The COC is required for <b>every shipment</b>:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• It Provides the Kenya Bureau of Standards and Customs with a proof that the goods being imported are in compliance with the relevant standards and technical regulations.</li><li>• It's a mandatory document for goods clearance at the border.</li></ul></li><li>• For consignments delivered to Kenya without CoC, importers may be issued a penalty of 15% CIF and are required to issue a bond 15% of the CIF value. The costs of the test will be charged to the importer as well. It is the seller's responsibility to ensure that shipments to Kenya are effected only upon issuance of a Certificate of Conformity or confirmed certification decision</li><li>• Otherwise KEBS is mandated to conduct destination inspection and may approve clearance of subject goods even without a COC</li></ul>
<b>Fees</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fees are payable in advance by the exporter. Fees are net of any tax present or future that may be applicable and are payable upon receipt of the order. (Request for Certification). Fees are due regardless of whether after assessment of the goods the exporter or importer does not provide the information or documents necessary for the final issuance of the CoC, or for any reason does not proceed with the shipment of the goods.</li><li>• The Fee structure is detailed in section 4.</li></ul>

### 2. Verification Requirements

<p><b>Procedure</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Request:</b> Importers submit request for CoC together with the initial set of supporting documents to SGS Liaison Office in Kenya or the SGS Country Office. The SGS Liaison Office registers the submission and notifies the SGS Executing Office in the country of Supply; alternatively, exporters may also trigger the process and contact directly SGS Country Office in their country who will provide them with the necessary information and guidance for obtaining a CoC.</li> <li><b>2. Verification:</b> The SGS Executing Office in the country of supply liaises with the exporter to request the mandatory documents and complementary information about the goods, i.e. detailed products description, place where the goods are available for verification as well as a copy of the invoice related to the shipment. The SGS Executing Office will then coordinate with the supplier/exporter for carrying out the applicable interventions (inspection, sampling/testing).</li> <li><b>3. Evaluation:</b> Reports from the verification activities (Inspection Report, Test Report(s)) together with the mandatory supporting documents are submitted to SGS Certification Centre for review against the regulatory requirements in force.</li> <li><b>4. Attestation:</b> The successful review of the various reports and other supporting documents lead to the issuance of Certificate of Conformity to evidence the compliance of the shipment. If discrepancies are identified, feedback is given to the exporter as well as guidance for implementing the necessary corrections to achieve compliance.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Inspection</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Purpose</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Product identification to confirm that the goods to be shipped correspond to those declared.</li> <li>• Verification that requirements not covered by supporting documentation (e.g. marking, labelling, packaging) are fulfilled.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Testing</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Test reports should be issued by an approved laboratory such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ISO 17025 Accredited Laboratories</li> <li>• An SGS Laboratory</li> <li>• Laboratories recognized by the Kenya Bureau of Standards.</li> <li>• Manufacturer’s laboratories (on a case by case basis following review and approval of the testing methods)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
